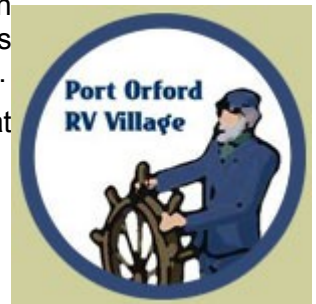
Business of the Month – Port Orford RV Village
